## **IT DOESN'T HAPPEN OVERNIGHT**

The 3/3/3 rule is a general guideline for the adjustment period of a pet after adoptions. Every pet is unique and will adjust differently. Please have patients and allow your new pet time to settle in.

## **3 DAYS** TO DECOMPRESS

- Feeling overwhelmed
- May feel scared or unsure of what's going on
- Not yet comfortable to be themself
- May not want to eat or drink
- Shuts down and/or hides under furniture
- Tests the boundaries

## **3 WEEKS** TO LEARN YOUR ROUTINE

- Starts settling in
- Feels more comfortable
- Realizes this could be their furever home
- Figures out their environment
- Gets into a routine
- Let's their guard down, beginning to show their personality
- Behavior issues may appear

## **3 MONTHS** TO START TO FEEL AT HOME

- Finally feels completely comfortable in their home
- Begins to build trust and a true bond
- Gains a complete sense of security with his new family
- Sets into a routine
