1 Cats tend to hide their illness

Cats instinctively hide their illnesses as in the wild a sick animal is an easy target for predators. This may mean they are hiding an illness long before you notice anything is wrong.

2 Over 50% of cats are overweight or obese

Overweight and obese cats are at risk for diabetes and heart, respiratory, and kidney disease and much more. Your veterinarian will check your cat's weight when you visit and help recommend a proper diet.

3 Cats age much faster than humans

The first year of a cat's life is the equivalent of 15 human years. Every year after that is roughly 4-5 human years. This means that they go through aging changes much faster than we do and it is crucial to detect and monitor any issues that may potentially pop up due to them getting older.

4 Prevent, don't react
